Day 3 ORLANDO: EXPLORE KENNEDY SPACE CENTER VISITOR COMPLEX (KSCVC)-PROGRAMME DAY2

- ✓ **KSC Bus Tour**-Tour to the birthplace of American space flight to see launch pads and the iconic Vehicle Assembly Building and restricted areas of working space flight facility in an air-conditioned motor coach.
- ✓ **Rocket Garden**-Capture the thrill of early space flight at the Rocket Garden. Walk among actual rockets of the Mercury,Gemini,and Apollo space programmes.
- ✓ **Space Shuttle Atlantis**-Get a close-up view of Atlantis, the only space shuttle displayed in flight. Space Shuttle Atlantis also includes more than 60 interactive exhibits celebrating the history, technology and impact of NASA's Space Shuttle Programmes.
- ✓ **Space Shuttle Simulation**-Strap in for a simulation of the space shuttle's eight-and-a-half-minute ascent into orbit! Enter the heart of space shuttle operations for a prelaunch briefing by veteran space shuttle commander Charles Bolden. Once on board, experience what veteran NASA astronauts call the next best thing to flying aboard the space shuttle.
- ✓ **Saturn V Complex**- Encounter monumental 363-foot rocket which is one of the most powerful rockets ever built with a spectacle of human engineering and space travel. Out of a total of 13 Saturn V rockets launched between 1967 and 1972, experience a close encounter with one of the only three remaining Saturn V Rockets in the U.S.
- ✓ **Apollo Treasures Gallery**-View an actual Apollo spacecraft and legendary artifacts in a display so immersive you can actually see the moon dust on Alan Shepard's spacesuit.
- ✓ **Moon Rock**-Encash the opportunity to touch an actual moon rock, returned to Earth.
- ✓ **Vehicle Assembly Building**-Witness One of the largest buildings in the world by area and world's fourth largest building by volume used to assemble Launch vehicles of NASA along with a pair of crawler-transporters, among the largest machines ever built to move on land, carried the assembled rockets to the pads.
- ✓ **IMAX Movies**-Two different larger-than-life films take you on an awe-inspiring journey into space on screens over five stories tall!
- ✓ **Science on Sphere**- View a global display system that uses computers and video projectors to display planetary data onto a six-foot diameter sphere, analogous to a giant animated globe with the aim of better representing global phenomenon and complex environmental processes.
- ✓ **Space Shop**- Shop to your heart's content for original NASA merchandise at NASA's largest Space Shop.
- Lunch at theKSCVC
- Shopping at **Wal-Mart** -Shop at America's multinational retailing corporation that operates as a chain of hypermarkets, discount department stores, and grocery stores.



- ✓ **United Nations Headquarter-** Design by Brazilian architect Oscar Niemeyer has served as the official headquarters of United Nations since its completion in 1952.

- ✓ **Brooklyn Bridge**- The national historic landmark & one of the best architectural & engineering marvels and oldest suspension bridges having trains, wagons and pedestrian pathways connecting the boroughs of Manhattan and Brooklyn.
 - ✓ **Madison Square Garden** – The World's Most Famous Arena & a multi-purpose indoor arena in the New York City borough of Manhattan where world's greatest concerts have taken place.
 - ✓ **Wall Street** – Located in Lower Manhattan is easily one of the most famous streets in the world, known for its role in the international financial system.
 - ✓ **Broadway Street**-A wide street and the main shopping drag in New York City that runs the full length of Manhattan. Filled with chic boutiques and national department stores, Broadway keeps shoppers happy and spending year-round.
 - ✓ **Shopping at Times Square** – Known as Crossroads of the World and world's most busiest pedestrian, Times Square is a major commercial intersection, tourist destination, entertainment center and neighbourhood in the Midtown Manhattan section of New York City at the junction of Broadway and Seventh Avenue. It is world's most visited place and known for its many Broadway theatres, cinemas and electronic billboards and one of those places that make New York a city that never sleeps.
